## **Clarification of Bulletin #19**

In Bulletin #19, we reported that two National Wildlife Federation (NWF) chapters endorsed the Alliance's mission. Dr. Douglas Inkley, Senior Science Advisor for the NWF, has written to let us know that the NWF does not have "chapters" as part of its organization. Rather, the New Mexico Wildlife Federation and the Albuquerque Wildlife Federation are separate and independent organizations which are called "affiliates" by the NWF. Such affiliates are free to adopt positions which may be contrary to those of the NWF. Our thanks to Dr. Inkley for calling the chapter/affiliate distinction to our attention.
